

CBS 2014 – PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

PODIUM PRESENTATIONS

Material presented must reflect that which is summarized in your submitted abstract. Presentations are limited to a maximum of 12 minutes, followed by 3 minutes for questions. You will be notified of your presentation time and session by email; presentation times will also be indicated in the final conference program that you will be given as part of your registration package (and posted as well to the conference website).

Please disclose any potential conflicts of interest, financial and otherwise, you may have on the first slide of your presentation ([a sample slide is provided](#)). This would include: receiving a payment, honorarium or support from a commercial organization for the work being presented; holding investments in a pharmaceutical or medical device company; or serving as a member on an Advisory Board or equivalent with a commercial organization. If you do not have any conflicts of interest, please indicate so ([a sample slide is provided](#)). Where possible, please use generic rather than trade names of medications and/or devices that may be included in your presentation.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Material presented must reflect that which is summarized in your submitted abstract. Poster numbers will be assigned in the conference program that you will be given as part of your registration package (and posted as well to the conference website). The Presenting authors with odd-numbered posters will be required to be present at their posters from 12:30-13:15 on Thursday, June 5th, and for the entire poster session on Friday, June 6th. The Presenting authors with even-numbered posters will be required to be present at their posters from 13:15-14:00 on Thursday, June 5th, and for the entire poster session on Friday, June 6th.

Posterboards for poster display are 4 ft x 4 ft. Therefore, your poster should not exceed 4 ft x 4 ft (*we recommend that you use a slightly smaller size to make sure that your poster fits on your assigned board*). Where possible, please use generic rather than trade names of medications and/or devices in your poster.
