Committee functions:

- 1) To adjudicate the selection process for a number of Canadian Biomaterials Society awards, including the two legacy funds generated contributed to the Society after the World Biomaterials Congress held in 2016 in Montreal
- 2) To promote these awards within the Society to ensure we have sufficient applicants for awards competitions
- 3) To prepare the annual reports on the awards
- 4) To revisit and revise the terms for each award based on the number and quality of applicants and propose new awards if necessary

The awards committee will consist of at least 4 members drawn from the pool from the Canadian Biomaterials Society members in good standing. Each member will serve a 2-year term with the years of service being staggered to ensure continuity.

The committee will meet at least twice a year (including the adjudication meeting for the aforementioned awards), either via teleconference or in person at the Annual Meeting or World Biomaterials Congress.
